If you lost your housing and now live in a shelter, motel, vehicle, camping ground, or temporary trailer; on the street; doubled-up with family or friends; or in another type of temporary or inadequate housing, your child might be able to receive help through a federal law called the McKinney-Vento Act.

School Lunch Information

Nutritious meals are available daily for a price of \$1.75 for breakfast, \$3.00 for lunch, and \$0.50 for a la carte milk. Each student is provided a lunch account onto which money may be deposited. Households are encouraged to pay towards their child's lunch balance in SchoolCafé. To learn more about SchoolCafé, please visit their website: www.schoolcafe.com.

To register for an account, please use this link: www.schoolcafe.com/register. You will find this campus name under the Riverwalk SST Discovery District. If you need help, please call the school and ask to speak with the Lunch Clerk.

Should a student's meal account balance fall below \$0, he /she will be allowed to charge up to -\$10.00. Once the negative meal account balance limit is reached, the student will receive an alternate meal. Alternate meals consist of cereal, fruit, and milk for breakfast; and for lunch, a sandwich, vegetable, and milk.

If a student is later approved for free meals, he/she will begin receiving meals immediately. However, the household is still responsible for paying the negative account balance.
