Dear Middle School Parents/Guardians,

As a parent, you have taught your child important life lessons since the day they were born and you have modeled the behaviors you expected. SST-Discovery reinforces those lessons through character education and expecting all staff to be positive role models. The close connection between the home and school is one important reason SST students are successful.

As we work with you to build the self-esteem of your child and good decision making skills, we also realize that middle school can be a challenging time. Rules and consequences become more significant when it comes to behavior.

Providing a safe schools is one of our greatest responsibilities. For that reason, SST may conduct random drug dog searches at middle and high school campuses. If you child mentions this to you, please know we do not have a drug use problem among our students. This is a standard procedure practiced at many schools. Students do not come in contact with the dogs and strict measures are taken to maintain student safety.

This also provides you as a parent with the opportunity to talk with your child about expectations and consequences. The consequence of having an illegal drug at an SST can result in expulsion based on the handbook. Reinforce the expectations you set for your child. Remind your child that each day counts and each decision has consequences. Talk with your child about friends and free time both in an out of school.

Again, our commitment is to provide an enriched learning experience for your child in a safe and nurturing environment. Drugs and alcohol are not tolerated at SST. Our focus is student success each and every day to provide so that our students will have the greatest opportunities to become high achieving professionals who make significant and meaningful contributions to their families and communities.
