FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Who can apply?

Admission to SST Schools is open to all students regardless of zoning.

2. How can I apply?

Please fill out an Application Form and submit it to the campus that you want to enroll your child(ren) in, via mail, fax or in person. You can also apply online on the Campus' website (see individual campus info).

3. Do I apply separately if I'm interested in more than one campus?

Yes, please apply for each individual campus that you are interested in, independently. We do not transfer any application among the campuses. Each campus application will be processed separately.

4. What happens if I am selected in the lottery process at more than one campus?

You may enroll at the campus of your choice, if you are selected at multiple campuses.

5. What grade levels do you serve?

It varies from campus to campus. Please see individual campus info.

6. Do you charge tuition?

No, SST Schools are public charter schools and funded by State and Federal Government.

7. Do you provide extra-curricular activities?

Yes, we do provide extra-curricular activities including academic, athletic and social clubs.

8. Are the students tested to be accepted to the school?

No, SST Schools, being open enrollment charter schools, do not test students as part of the admission process.

9. Do you provide breakfast/hot lunch for students?

Yes, we serve breakfast and hot lunch for our students. As a public school, we have free/reduced lunch program for eligible students.

10. Do you provide transportation?

Unfortunately, we do not provide transportation.

11. Do students wear uniform?

Yes, SST Schools are uniform schools.

12. What are the times of operation?

It is from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. After-school is generally between 3:00 PM and 6:00 PM.
