SST-Discovery Uniform

SST-Discovery School Uniform for all students:

- Khaki or Navy Blue Pants—no cargo styles (**NO** shorts or skirts)
- Shoes—Black or White Tennis Shoes—No sandals, heels, flip-flops.
 - Black or Navy Blue Belt—must be worn at all times.
- Uniform Shirt is purchased at the school. Available for purchase at Orientation.

REMINDERS:

- Boys may not wear jewelry and accessories such as rings, earrings, and necklaces.
- Girls—Jewelry and accessories should be appropriate for school and not attract undue attention (only a pair of rings and a pair of earrings are permitted). All other piercing must be removed while on campus.
 - No bracelets allowed.
 - Girls may not wear excessive make up. Boys are not allowed to wear any make up.
 - No facial or body piercing.
 - No tattoos.
 - No extreme hairstyles and hair colors.

Outerwear:

- No hats, caps, bandanna, and other headgear and outwear such as windbreakers, jean jackets, or ski jackets. No jackets or coats are to be worn into the classrooms. They must be kept in locker at all times. On cold days, students may wear long sleeve t-shirts under their uniform shirt. These shirts should be white, black, navy or gray. A navy colored uniform sweater may also be worn and should not have a hood.

ALL 4TH THRU 8TH GRADE STUDENTS

Students in 4th thru 8th Grades have a Dress Code Requirement for P.E. On days where these students have P.E., they are required to dress out for class.
